Cheating:

- Exchanging information with others in exams,

- Taking all or only a part of an assignment, project and/or report from another student, professional, or source and presenting it as one's own.

Patterns of plagiarism:

- Benefitting from printed or published sources without specifying the source,
- Using quotations from different sources without citing the source,
- Using the results in a source as they are or by changing them partially without citing the source,
- Duplicating lecture notes or materials belonging to the instructor without the permission of the instructor and allowing others to use it.

The main behaviors for cheating are:

- Taking exams on behalf of others and/or processing attendance and/or directing others in this regard,
- Showing unused resources as if they were used,
- Presenting someone else's ideas as their own
- Having all academic research and work done by someone else.

ETHICAL VALUES REGARDING DISCRIMINATION AND HARASSMENT

STUDENT AFFAIRS OFFICE

Student Affairs Office is responsible for informing all students about academic and administrative issues beginning from their registration until their graduation. Student advisors help them in their communication with administrative/academic staff and work in coordination with the related units.

All procedures are carried out by the Department Secretariat and the Faculty Student Unit. The control of the processes, the follow-up of the processes and the graduation procedures are carried out by the Registrar's Office. The International Student Unit (<http://www.admissions.yildiz.edu.tr/>) serves under the Registrar's Office.

STUDENT INFORMATION SYSTEM (OBS)

Yıldız Technical University Student Information System (OBS) is a role-based internet application developed through the use of reliable and application servers in order to ensure coordination between Faculty, Department, Faculty Members, Student, and Administrative units regardless of time and place and to achieve the best performance in the shortest time.

INTRODUCTION TO OBS

Upon clicking on the Applications tab in the upper right corner of our university's web page (<https://www.yildiz.edu.tr/>) and selecting OBS from the opened page, the login page will open (<https://obs.yildiz.edu.tr/oibs./student/login.aspx>).

- *Newly registered students can enter the OBS system with their username (eight-digit student number) and temporary password. Information about the temporary password is given in detail below.*
- *Your temporary password is the serial number of your TR Identity Card. When entering the ID card serial number, you should not add spaces or “_” character.*
- *In addition, you can create your temporary password by clicking the “I forgot my password” option on the Login Screen and then entering the requested information.*
- *When you log in, you will be automatically asked to change your password. To change the password later, click Change Password from the User Operations menu and enter the password you want to create.*
- *OBS username and password will be active together with the course selection dates in the academic calendar. **For the security of the records in the system, maximum care should be taken not to share the password with anyone and it should be kept during the whole education period.***

OPERATIONS PERFORMED WITH OBS

By logging into OBS, our students can add and delete courses, view the courses taken, weekly course schedule, their grade point average, internship information and personal information. They can also update address information and register for the Foreign Language Proficiency Exam.

CAMPUS CARD

What is Campus Card/What is it used for?

The student ID Card, which is a magnetic, electronic card, is given free of charge at the first registration. It is used at the campus entrance, cafeteria, library operations, in-campus and inter-campus shuttle services, social facilities (fitness, pool, football field, etc.). As a school ID, the campus card is personal. Its use by others is treated as a disciplinary action.

I have just enrolled in the university. Where/ How Will I Get My Campus Card?

When you first register, the department secretaries will deliver your student card free of charge.

How Do I Top Up My Campus Card?

In order to load money on your campus card, you must first open a checking account at İşbank and have a debit or credit card. You can load balance from İşbank ATMs and from the education payments section of İş Mobile application. For the balances loaded after 11.30, you need to have your card scanned by the identification devices in the cafeterias.

I Lost My Campus Card. What should I do?

If you lose your campus card, you must request a new card by filling out the form on the application link below. You can receive your card from the E-Yıldız office in three business days after your application.

Is There a Fee in Case of Card Loss/Magnetic Failure?

If you lose or renew your card, you must pay a certain fee from your credit or debit card to E-Yıldız office. No fee is charged for cases other than loss or renewal.

Turnstiles do not read my campus card. What should I do?

You have to apply to E-Yıldız office.

I changed my department. How Can I Update My Card?

You have to apply to the E-Yıldız office.

How Can I Update the Picture on My Card?

You should send an e-mail (eyildizofisi@gmail.com) to E-Yıldız office, explaining the reason for the update along with your new picture. Afterwards, you can get your new card, provided that you come to E-Yıldız office within three working days and deliver your old card.



COURSE REGISTRATIONS

The guides, which contain all the information regarding the course registration process, can be found on the left menu of the Registrar's Office website (<http://www.ogi.yildiz.edu.tr/>) shortly before the course registration dates specified in the academic calendar of our university. Registrations / Spring Semester Course Registrations are announced under such headings. To carry out the course registration process correctly, the guides should be examined.

- Students who start their undergraduate education from the first year can complete the course selection process by logging in via the APPLICATIONS/OBS option at the top of our University website (<https://www.yildiz.edu.tr/>) with the username and password they will be provided with as explained in 1.1. Those who start English Preparatory Education do not choose any courses.
- Course selection process must be done within the periods specified in the Academic Calendar. Each semester without registration renewal is counted within the maximum period of study.



TRANSITIONS, DOUBLE MAJOR AND MINOR PROGRAMS

Students who enroll in our university's programs can apply for Horizontal Transfer and Double Major Programs if they meet the necessary conditions. The Directives and Principles regarding Transitions and Double Major can be accessed under the heading Legislation / Regulations and Directives on the left menu at www.ogi.yildiz.edu.tr. Guidelines on these issues are prepared separately for each year and announced at www.ogi.yildiz.edu.tr before the application dates specified in the Academic Calendar, under the headings of Internal Transfer / Inter-University Transfer and Double Major. In addition to these, you can pursue a minor program at our university. Provided that students enrolled in an undergraduate program meet the necessary criteria, they are allowed to take courses from another education program they are interested in. Certificates are given to students who successfully complete their minor programs.

CAREER JOURNEY AT YTU

The aim of the Student Guidance and Career Center(SGCC) is to enable our students to get to know themselves during their education, to support their career planning in line with the needs of the business world, and to ensure that they are placed in internships and part-time jobs where they can improve themselves during their education and after graduation. Our Center organizes trainings, seminars, and events to enable students, graduates, and employees to increase their Career Planning and Development competencies by considering their talents, knowledge, skills, interests, and wishes.

The CO-OP Education Model serves as a bridge between the business world and the university with the aim of enabling students to gain work experience in businesses for an entire semester. Thanks to the CO-OP Education Model, students have the opportunity to combine the academic knowledge they gain at Yıldız Technical University with practical expertise in the business world. In this way, students get the chance to show their talents during the CO-OP Training and become privileged candidates in the recruitment process of enterprises.

The Dean of Students Office aims to solve the life problems of the students during their education at Yıldız Technical University and to provide them with the necessary support so that they can have peaceful, productive, and successful time at university. It provides services and communication in academic resources, accessibility, career, school rules and legal issues, financial and administrative support and assistance, health and psychological counseling resources, security, and student community.

For this purpose, we serve our students with four units; Psychological Counseling (PC), Peer Counseling (PC), First Year Experience (FYE), and Culture-Art-Design-Sports (CADS) Unit. In addition, a platform for introduction to University life is created with the living board, family day activities, orientation days, and YTU1911 course.

PSYCHOLOGICAL COUNSELING UNIT

In the PC Unit of the Dean of Students Office, our students are served by clinical specialist psychologists, psychologists, and psychological counselors. In addition, through service procurement, psychiatrists, clinical specialist psychologists, psychologists, and psychological counselors are employed, and a team of nine people supports the personal health problems of our students.

Interviews with our experts are carried out in line with professional ethics and principles. The principle of trust and confidentiality is fully fulfilled. The conversations you have will not be shared with other people without your permission. However, the people you mention in the first meeting can be contacted when your life or someone else's life is in danger. Even in this case, you will be contacted before sharing information with others.

PEER COUNSELING UNIT

As an individual, a person wants to talk, share and to be listened, understood and accepted. For this reason, he or she needs bonds established with feelings of intimacy and closeness. Since we have similar developmental experiences with our peers, the best people to understand and help them are **YOU ESTEEMED YTU STUDENTS.**

The Peer Counseling program, carried out as a pilot study with our volunteer students in the fall and spring semesters of 2021-2022, has been completed. Our main goal is to strengthen our students' communication skills, to guide students who are just starting our university, to support volunteer students who receive education on social and academic issues throughout the year, and to support other students who want to get help within the scope of the Peer Counseling program.

For this purpose, the students selected as Peer Counselors are given 90 minutes of training, 45 minutes of theory, and 45 minutes of practical training in six sessions.

FIRST YEAR EXPERIENCE AND INTRODUCTION TO UNIVERSITY LIFE - YTU 1911 COURSE

YTU Orientation Days are organized to present basic information about university life, introduce the places you will use during your education life and relevant people and bring together your friends who share the same passion, desires, and even concerns as you. Through the YTU 1911 course, all first-year students are informed about university life in various subjects. You can watch the program of the previous academic year at orientasyon.yildiz.edu.tr. YTU Orientation Days and YTU1911 course program are renewed every year and sent to the e-mail addresses of first-year students. Orientation days are held during the official opening week announced in the academic calendar in October.



CULTURE-ART-DESIGN-SPORTS UNIT

The Dean of Students Office aims to create an intellectual environment with broad involvement of our students planning cultural, artistic, design, and sports activities. The student clubs' activities suggested individually or as a group are implemented with the support of mentors on the relevant issues. Mentors are academicians who are experts in culture, art, design, and sports.

NUTRITION, HOUSING AND SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Meals are served to approximately 10 thousand people on YTU campuses. Both campus areas have school dining halls as well as various cafeterias and restaurants. School lunch is offered at the most affordable price in our country. You can follow the Meal menus, which are two meals a day (lunch and evening), at www.sks.yildiz.edu.tr. There is a dormitory for our female students in our Davutpaşa Campus. There is also a dormitory facility for graduate students.

Scholarships given by YTU; SCHOLARSHIP COORDINATION UNIT

Scholarships, funded internally or externally, are awarded to Yıldız Technical University students through the Scholarship Coordination Unit. For the 2022-2023 academic year, a scholarship of 6,000,000,00 TL will be provided to 1000 students through the YTU Foundation.

Need-based Scholarship

- It is given to students who are determined to be in need. Cash scholarships are funded by the YTU Foundation and other foundations/institutions/organizations.
- Students who apply online and document their financial situation within the application period announced by the YTU Scholarship Office at the beginning of each academic year are evaluated and invited for interviews. After the interviews, candidate students who meet the criteria of the YTU Foundation and other foundations/institutions/organizations are determined as a result of the evaluations made by the Scholarship Office. Additional documents may be requested from prospective students. Student files are sent to foundations/institutions/organizations when these documents are completed.
- The finalization of the students' scholarships depends on the approval of the foundations/institutions/organizations.

- The priority to receive a scholarship is for the preparatory and first four semester students.
- Students who do not exceed their standard education period and whose GPAs are at least 2.00 can apply for a scholarship. The scholarship is terminated at the end of the academic year if the student's GPA is below 2.00. Those who cannot complete preparatory education in one year cannot receive a scholarship until they start their undergraduate studies. These students must reapply for the required scholarship when they start their courses in the program.
- Need-based scholarships continue as long as preparatory students have the right to attend classes. Those who cannot complete preparatory school in one year cannot receive a scholarship until they start their undergraduate studies. These students have to reapply for the need-based scholarship when they start their undergraduate education.
- The suspended scholarships can be renewed with the decision of the Scholarship Coordinator and according to the quota.
- More than one scholarship can be granted to a student according to his/her needs (such as Requirements and Food Scholarship). However, a student cannot get more than one cash scholarship (except for KYK Education Loan).



Food Scholarship

- It is given to students who are determined to be in need. YTU Health and Sports Department finances food scholarships.
- Eligible candidates are determined as a result of evaluations made by the Scholarship Office among the students who apply online and document their financial situation during the application period announced by the YTU Scholarship Office at the beginning of each academic year. The finalization of the students' scholarships depends on the approval of the YTU Health and Sports Department.
- It is a free meal scholarship at the university cafeteria. It is valid for one academic year.
- In case a student uses less than 50% of his/her meal allowance each semester, his/her food scholarship is terminated.

Other Scholarship Opportunities

In order to receive scholarships given by public institutions, it is necessary to apply directly to public institutions. The institutions follow the continuation of the scholarships themselves. In addition, foundations, institutions and organizations that provide scholarships through YTU support our scholarship system.

STUDENT CLUBS

In our university, students have established clubs to perform extracurricular social, cultural, and sports activities according to their interests as well as to develop themselves socially and culturally and gain the habit of resting and having fun with new interests. As a leading university with YTU Clubs, there are 67 student clubs and societies working under these clubs. First-year students meet all clubs during the ORIENTATION DAYS and apply to at least one club as a member within the scope of YTU 1911 course.

In addition to the social and cultural venues of the university, through the CLUBS VALLEY, which was put into service in 2021, student clubs were brought together.

LIBRARY AND DOCUMENTATION CENTER

Martyr Prof. Dr. İlhan Varank Central Library on our Davutpaşa Campus has a capacity of 550 people and consists of a Computer Laboratory for 36 people, two group study halls and three quiet study halls. Our two halls are open 24/7 during the academic term, between 08.30 and 16.40 during the fall break and summer, and 24/7 throughout the year, including public and administrative holidays.

Şevket Sabancı Branch Library located on our Yıldız Campus has a capacity of 350 people and consists of a Computer Laboratory for 20 people and three study halls. During the academic semester, it is open between 08.30-23.00 on weekdays and between 10.00-18.00 on weekends. It is open between 08.30-16.30 in the fall break and summer periods and it is closed on weekends.

SOCIAL FACILITIES, CULTURE AND HEALTH OPPORTUNITIES

We have venues for sports, health facilities and cultural activities on our Davutpaşa and Yıldız Campuses. In order to benefit from all facilities and opportunities, you can review the conditions and forms announced on the web sites of SKS, Communication Coordinatorship and related web pages.



SPORTS FACILITIES

SEMI-OLYMPIC INDOOR SWIMMING POOL

To use the pool, you must first become a member. Membership is free; membership conditions, required documents, fees, session days and hours, detailed information about the pool are published on the website of our Department of Health, Culture and Sports. Students who want to use the facility regularly can pay a daily fee or have a monthly subscription. In addition, swimming lessons are provided for non-swimmers. Cash is not taken for fee payments, payments are made by credit card from the pos device. Entrances and exits are via the turnstiles by means of personalized cards.

FITNESS HALL (MIXED-FEMALE)

In our halls located in Davutpaşa Campus, users do sports according to the program given by our sports instructors. In addition, in the indoor pool building, there is a women-only lounge with the same features as the mixed fitness hall. Fitness Centers are only open to institution personnel, students, retirees and graduates. Fitness centers cannot be used by people outside the university. Information about membership conditions, required documents, and fees is available on the website. You need to become a member in order to use sports facilities. Payments are made only by credit card. Entrances and exits are via the turnstiles by means of personalized cards.



SPORTS AREAS

There is one astro football pitch on Davutpaşa Campus of our university. In order to use the astro pitch, users must make a reservation. In addition, there are basketball and volleyball courts in both campus areas.

Davutpaşa Campus has two tennis courts. The courts can be used by making a reservation one day before at the Fitness Center information office and paying a fee. Reservations are made for two players.

All licensed club athletes and disabled members of our school benefit from the facilities free of charge during the academic period all year round.

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MEDICAL SOCIAL CENTER

In the Mediko Social Centers located on Yıldız Technical University Yıldız and Davutpaşa Campuses, health services are provided to students, academic-administrative personnel, their family members and retired personnel from our University. There are also four expert counselor rooms used by the Psychological Counseling Unit of the Dean of Students Office in this center.
